#### DESCRIPTION:

StoneX (formerly INTL FCStone) has not terminated any business relationships due to viewpoints or beliefs, even though it does not have viewpoint or religious protections for employees. It does not discriminate against religious groups in its charitable giving. There are no known instances of its CEO or the company at large weaponizing its reputation or corporate funds for ideological purposes hostile to freedom of expression. For these reasons, StoneX Group receives a "Lower Risk" rating.

### Corporate Weaponization

*StoneX's charitable giving is centered around financially supporting various nonprofits working abroad through its Global Payments Division. The Global Payments Division "provides customized foreign exchange and treasury services to customers including international aid and development organizations, UN agencies, government agencies, NGOs, religious entities, multinational corporations, and financial institutions" (1). It does not discriminate against religious groups.*

**Employment policies fail to protect against discrimination based on political affiliation/views and/or religion.** High Risk

*StoneX does not protect its employees from religious or viewpoint discrimination (1)(2).*

### Corporate Governance and Public Policy

**Uses corporate reputation to support ideological causes and/or organizations hostile to freedom of expression.** Lower Risk

*There are no known instances of StoneX or its CEO using the company's corporate reputation to advance an ideological agenda (1).*
