DESCRIPTION:

Invitae Corporation, a biotechnology company, does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees. However, the company has not publicly terminated business relationships based on views or beliefs. Invitae also signed multiple statements in opposition to anti-LGBTQ legislation. However, the company does not appear to discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or beliefs. Invitae opposed various state and local legislation intended to protect parental rights, girlsâ€TM sports, bathroom facilities, and gendered spaces. However, the company has not used its corporate funds or lobbied for ideological purposes. For these reasons, Invitae Corporation receives a Lower Risk rating.

Corporate Weaponization

Has denied service to customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious Lower Risk beliefs OR corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries.

Invitae has not publicly fired customers, suppliers, or vendors based on political views or religious beliefs (1).

Charitable giving (including employee matching programs) policies or practices discriminate Lower Risk against charitable organizations based on views or religious beliefs.

Invitae does not appear to discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or beliefs. The company focuses on funding organizations that support genetic counseling programs as well as wider STEM education efforts (1)(2).

Employment policies fail to protect against discrimination based on political affiliation/views Medium Risk and/or religion.

Invitae does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees (<u>1</u>).

Corporate Governance and Public Policy

Uses corporate reputation to support ideological causes and/or organizations hostile to freedom High Risk of expression.

Invitae opposed the Florida Parental Rights in Education Act, which would prohibit teaching gender identity and sexual orientation to kids in K-3rd grade (<u>12</u>).



Uses corporate funds to advance ideological causes, organizations, or policies hostile to freedom Lower Risk of expression.

Invitae has not used corporate funds to advance ideological causes, organizations, or policies (1).

Uses corporate political contributions for ideological, non-business purposes.

Invitae does not operate a PAC at this time but has not lobbied for ideological purposes (1)(2)(3).
