DESCRIPTION:

Everlane, a clothing retailer, does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees. However, the company has not publicly terminated business relationships based on views or beliefs. Everlane has funded the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) and supports BLM. The company provides a benefits package for employees which covers travel/lodging costs for an abortion. Everlane is a member of the "Don't Ban Equality" business coalition. However, the company does not appear to discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or beliefs. For these reasons, Everlane receives a Lower Risk rating.

Corporate Weaponization

Has denied service to customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious Lower Risk beliefs OR corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries.

Everlane has not publicly fired customers, suppliers, or vendors based on political views or religious beliefs (1).

Charitable giving (including employee matching programs) policies or practices discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or religious beliefs.

Lower Risk

Everlane does not appear to discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or beliefs. The company focuses on funding organizations that support, "environmentalism and sustainability" (1).

Employment policies fail to protect against discrimination based on political affiliation/views and/or religion.

Medium Risk

Everlane does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees (1).

Corporate Governance and Public Policy

Uses corporate reputation to support ideological causes and/or organizations hostile to freedom **Medium Risk** of expression.

Everlane urged its customers to vote and engage in activism in support of the Black Lives Matter movement in 2020 (12).



Uses corporate funds to advance ideological causes, organizations, or policies hostile to freedom High Risk of expression.

Everlane provides a benefits package for employees which covers travel/lodging costs for an abortion (1). The company launched a collection of clothes following the Supreme Court's overturn of Roe v. Wade, and proceeds from the collection went to the ACLU's program to uphold pro-abortion legislation (2).

Uses corporate political contributions for ideological, non-business purposes.
