DESCRIPTION:

Tinuiti is Medium Risk. The company often yields to political activism in shaping corporate governance, potentially alienating consumers, dividing employees, and harming shareholders. The company implements race and identity-based policies that replace merit, excellence, and integrity with preferential treatment and outcomes. Tinuiti occasionally embraces corporate initiatives that redirect its central focus from business goals to partisan policies and divisive issues at times. This approach fails to safeguard free exercise, free speech, and free enterprise.

Corporate Weaponization

Has canceled customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious beliefs OR Medium Risk corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries.

Tinuiti received a score of 45 on the 2025 Corporate Equality Index (CEI) from the Human Rights Campaign (HRC), a political stakeholder group. The company recruits employees based on sexual identity issues. The company discriminates against vendors that do not promote divisive sex and gender policies, indicating it prioritizes sexual issues over merit (1)(2). However, Tinuiti has not publicly canceled customers, suppliers, or vendors based on political views or religious beliefs (3).

Charitable giving (including employee matching programs) policies or practices discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or religious beliefs.

High Risk

Tinuiti's HRC 2025 CEI rating indicates the company will not donate to non-religious charities unless they embrace controversial sexual identity policies (1)(2). The company does not publish charitable giving guidelines (3).

Employment policies fail to protect against viewpoint or other discrimination and/or are ideological in nature.

Medium Risk

Tinuiti does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees (1)(2).

Corporate Governance and Public Policy

Tinuiti operates a Diversity Council, Inclusion Lab and Diversity Dialogue Spaces ($\underline{1}$). The company uses its blog to publish articles on Inclusive Media and in support of HRC's CEI ($\underline{2}$)($\underline{3}$). Tinuiti uses its X account to support HRC initiatives ($\underline{4}$)($\underline{5}$). The company supports an initiative published by E.L.F. Cosmetics on its X account. This initiative requires companies to meet racial and gender diversity quotas in company boards ($\underline{6}$). The company opposed various state and local legislation intended to protect parental rights, girls' sports, bathroom facilities, and gendered spaces ($\underline{7}$)($\underline{8}$).
