DESCRIPTION:

Crocs has not publicly terminated business relationships based on views or beliefs. The company protects its employees against viewpoint discrimination. Crocs provides a benefits package for employees which covers travel/lodging costs for an abortion and has funded a drag show featuring a "kids' fashion show." The company partnered with the Gay and Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation (GLAAD) by releasing a Pride collection intended to "drive awareness around the organization's efforts". For these reasons, Crocs receives a Medium Risk rating.

In 2021, Crocs partnered with the Gay and Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation (GLAAD) by releasing a Pride collection intended to "drive awareness around the organization's efforts" (<u>5</u>). Crocs engaged in a similar GLAAD partnership in 2022 (<u>6</u>).
