Lower Risk

DESCRIPTION:

Afterpay has not terminated business relationships due to ideological beliefs. Afterpay has used its corporate reputation to promote ideological organizations such as Black Lives Matter (BLM) and Reimagine Gender. However, Afterpay has not corporately donated to ideological groups. For these reasons, Afterpay receives a "Lower Risk" rating.

Corporate Weaponization

Has denied service to customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious beliefs OR corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries. Lower Risk

Afterpay has not publicly fired customers, suppliers, or vendors due to political or religious beliefs.

Charitable giving (including employee matching programs) policies or practices discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or religious beliefs. Lower Risk

Afterpay partnered with two charities: A Common Thread and Baby2Baby, where it donated \$200,000 in total to the two charities (1). Afterpay has not published its charitable giving guidelines.

Employment policies fail to protect against discrimination based on political affiliation/views and/or religion. High Risk

Afterpay does not protect its employees from viewpoint discrimination (1).

Corporate Governance and Public Policy

Uses corporate reputation to support ideological causes and/or organizations hostile to freedom of expression. High Risk

Afterpay has partnered with various groups that promote radical LGBTQ gender ideology, such as Reimagine Gender (1). Afterpay has openly endorsed the BLM movement (2).

Uses corporate funds to advance ideological causes, organizations, or policies hostile to freedom of expression. Lower Risk

Afterpay has not used corporate dollars to support ideological groups hostile to freedom of expression (1).

Uses corporate political contributions for ideological, non-business purposes.
