DESCRIPTION:

Valmont, an American manufacturer, vet's international vendors for LGBTQ policies and does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees. However, it has not publicly terminated business relationships based on views or beliefs. The company requires suppliers to abide by its ESG requirements and implements ESG principles into all aspects of its business. However, Valmont has not used its corporate funds for ideological purposes. For these reasons, Valmont receives a Medium Risk rating.

Corporate Weaponization

Has denied service to customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious beliefs OR corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries.

Medium Risk

Valmont promotes divisive sex and gender policies. Its Global Supplier Code of Conduct requires international vendors to include sexual orientation and gender reassignment in their nondiscrimination policy (1). However, it has not publicly terminated business relationships due to religious beliefs or political views.

Charitable giving (including employee matching programs) policies or practices discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or religious beliefs.

Valmont does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees (1)(2).
