#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Natura & Co vets vendors according to LGBTQ policies but provides viewpoint protections for its employees. It has not publicly terminated business relationships based on views or beliefs. Avon Brazil, a subsidiary of Natura & Co, advocates for ethnic-racial equity through its Project DIVA program. However, the company does not discriminate against charitable organizations based on view or belief and has not used its corporate funds for ideological purposes. For these reasons, Natura & Co receives a Lower Risk rating.Â

### **Corporate Weaponization**

Has denied service to customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious M beliefs OR corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries.

Medium Risk

Natura & Co has a written policy pledging to vet vendors for LGBTQ policies. Its Code of Conduct applies to all suppliers and includes a commitment to not discriminate on the basis of sexual orientation (1). The company has not publicly fired customers, suppliers, or vendors based on political views or religious beliefs.

Charitable giving (including employee matching programs) policies or practices discriminate against charitable organizations based on views or religious beliefs.
