DESCRIPTION:

Cumulus Media fired all employees unwilling to get the COVID-19 vaccine, denying most employee claims to religious or other exemptions. Cumulus Media threatened to fire radio hosts like Mark Levin and Dan Bongino for speaking about election fraud. The company does not provide viewpoint protections for its employees and its CEO is a signatory of CEO Action for Diversity and Inclusion. For these reasons, Cumulus Media receives a High Risk rating.

Corporate Weaponization

Has denied service to customers, suppliers, or vendors due to their political views or religious Hig beliefs OR corporately boycotts, divests, or sanctions regions, people groups, or industries.

Cumulus Media fired all employees unwilling to get the COVID-19 vaccine, denying most employees claims to religious or other exemptions (1). Cumulus Media threatened to fire Mark Levin and Dan Bongino, two conservative radio hosts, over claims of election fraud (2).

Cumulus Media requires anti-racism and unconscious bias training for all employees (1). The company's CEO signed the CEO Action for Diversity & Inclusion pledge, which includes a commitment to promote DEI through bias education training in the workplace (2). Cumulus Media published its DEI expansion and its airing of Bad With Money in support of the LGBTQ movement (3).
